In Full Swing

Although June was a cold and wet month, construction is really heating up and progressing rapidly.

The entire structure of the new synagogue is standing. This includes the Village Center and Sanctuary structure which we just completed this past month. You may also notice that we recently erected both the East and West entrance canopies.

The next major milestone will be placing the roof assemblies throughout the Village Center and Sanctuary. This will take place during the first two weeks in July.

We are also working on enclosing the exterior walls. This includes installation of the glass and glazing systems, the VMZinc metal wall panels and sheathing / weather barriers around the Sanctuary.

We are also *In Full Swing* throughout the building interiors. Ceilings are being framed throughout the Admin / Chapel / Social Hall / Pre-K areas, walls are being taped and primed, MEP rough-in continues within ceilings and wall cavities throughout. We also transitioned into major sitework activities. This includes placing curbs and gutters, rough grading the parking lot in anticipation of asphalt and finish grading landscape green spaces.

The access road between CJHS and BJBE's new east lot also started late June and should be complete no later than July 15th. The roadway has been cut, graded and stoned for asphalt placement. We are anticipating that the first lift of asphalt will be placed following the July 4th holiday.

A few of the "finishing touches" such as the slate wall tile and metal wall panels will begin to be installed in July. This should make for some unique progress photos next month.
